


## **CPPP Quarterly Report: Q3 (January - March)**

FY 2021 - 2022





During the 3rd Quarter of FY 2021/2022, Kern County continued to stay under the state ordered quarantine due to the Covid-19 pandemic. This is the 8<sup>th</sup> Quarter our county and state have operated under Covid-19 restrictions.

As reported in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter & 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter reports, Kern Behavioral Health & Recovery Services (KernBHRS) and the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) continues to experience changes in personnel leaving our team with several vacancies. As of the end of March 2022, our team has one additional vacant position which make a total of three vacant positions.



We are expecting our vacant Office Services Tech (OST) – Extra Help to return in late April 2022. We will continue to work with KernBHRS Human Resources team to find qualified candidates to fill vacancies.


#### **CPPP Participation**

However, not everyone responded to our request to provide feedback using our Demographic surveys; we were only able to collect data from a total of **71** participants; this is an increase of **31%** (*compared to 54 in Q2*).

















#### STAKEHOLDER REPRESENTATION




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#### **STAKEHOLDER IDENTIFIED NEEDS**
