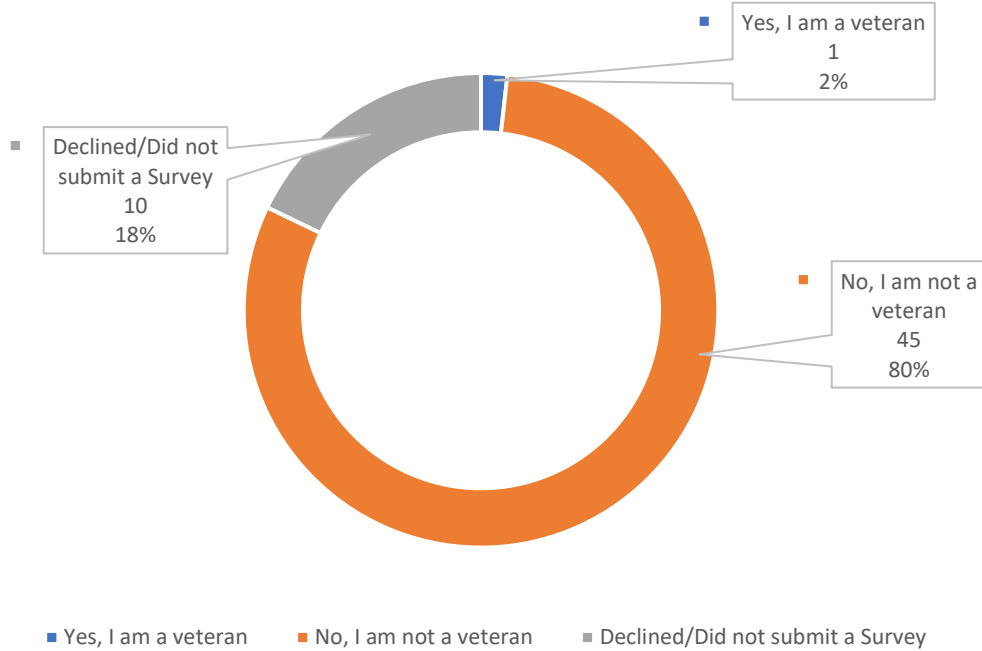


DEMOGRAPHICS OF STAKEHOLDERS

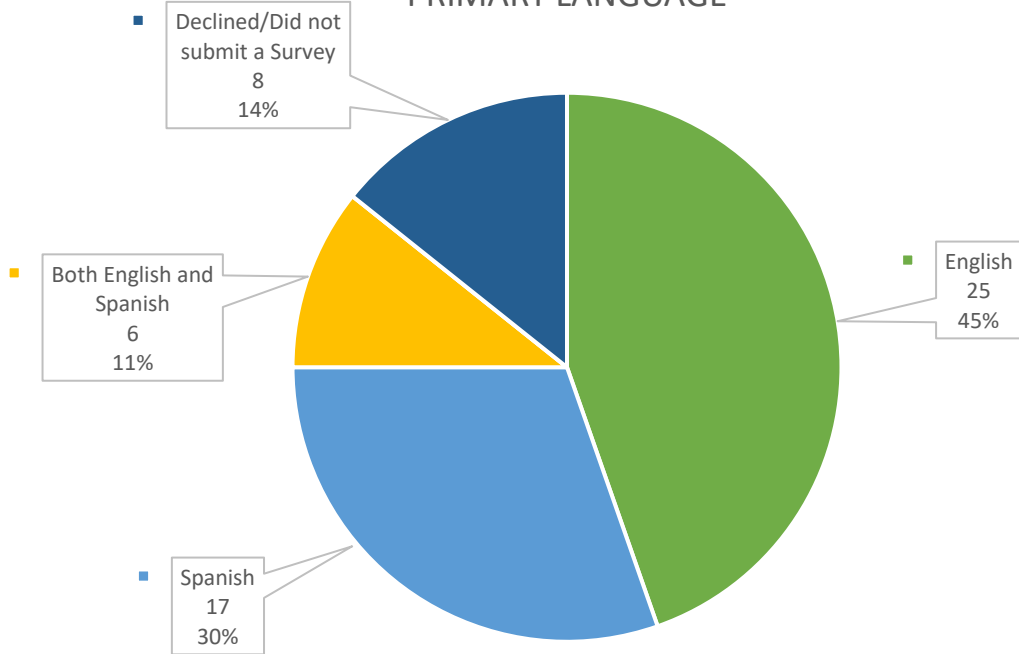

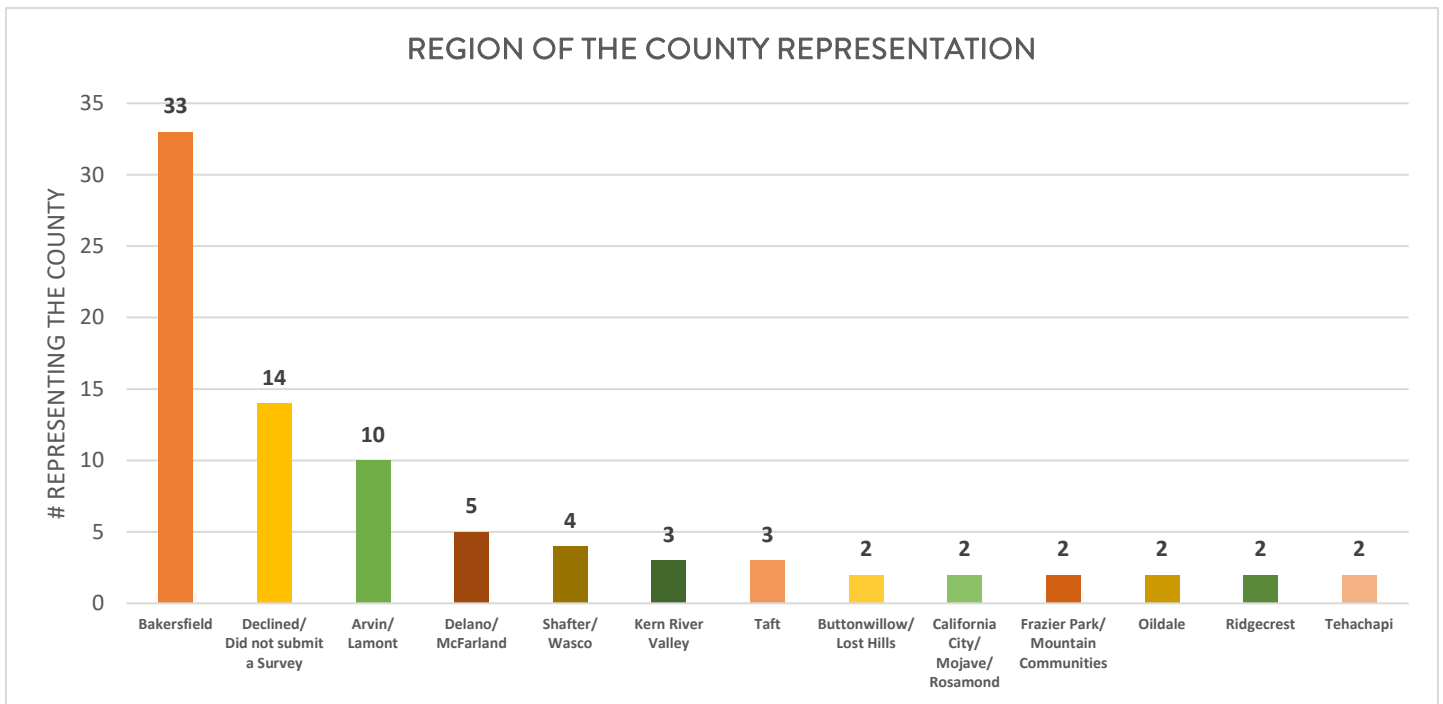
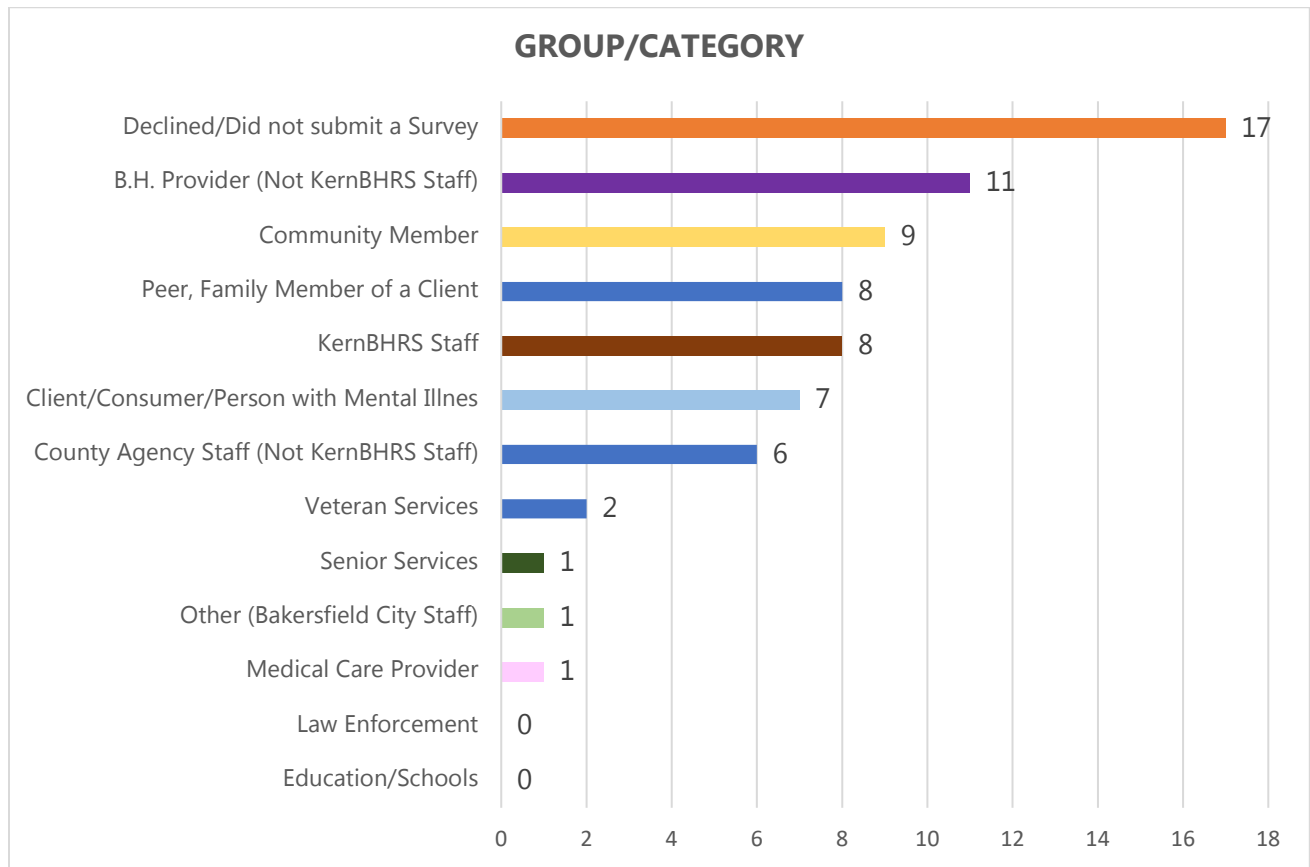


PRIMARY LANGUAGE

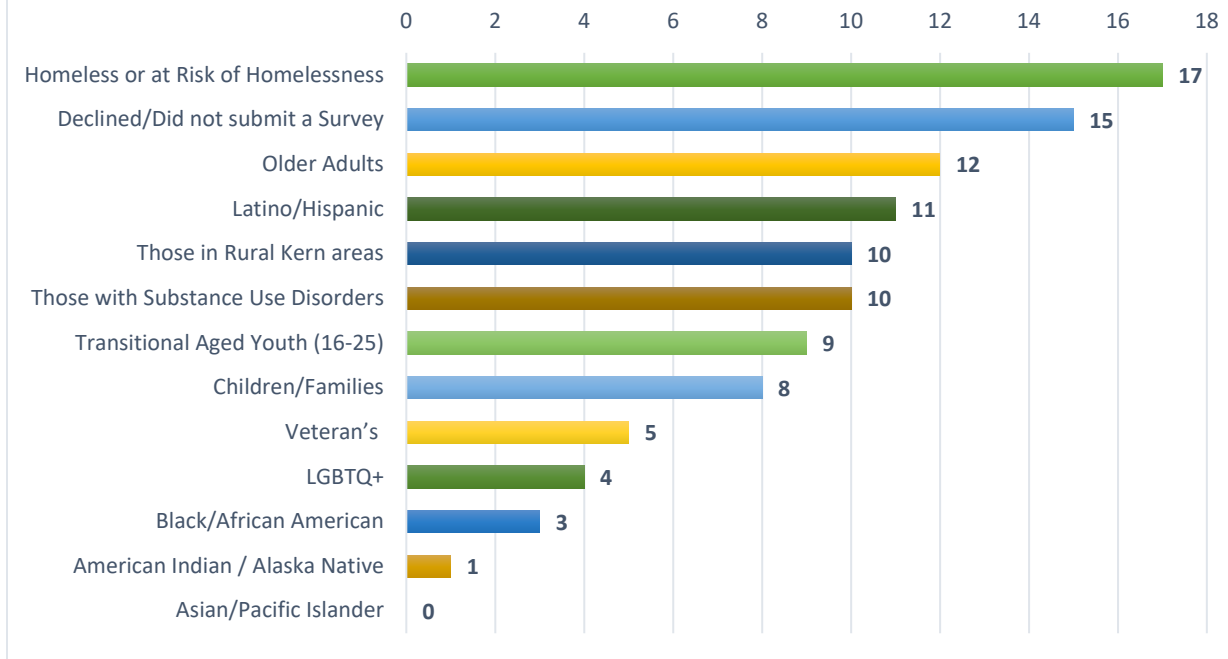






STAKEHOLDER REPRESENTATION
